FreedomFlix walk through. This is meant to be a guide on how to present FreedomFlix to a customer.

Log in – with digital locker preference as an educator. Use the title *America's Struggle with Terrorism* as the title to present. Follow the navigation bar on the left side as the order in presenting the features.

Watch the video

Each title/unit contains an introductory 60-90 second video meant to engage the learner

Click on the e-book, and go into the e-book

- Show how the Table of Contents is hyperlinked to jump through the book
- Show the Glossary feature
- Turn the Read Aloud feature on, and show how you can choose the speed you want it on and how the words are highlighted as you go along
- And point out how all captions, sidebars, and vocabulary terms (in bold) can be read-aloud – anywhere you see headphones can be read-aloud
- Show the Zoom feature and how you can zoom in and out as needed
- Show how to highlight passages on any page(s)
- Show how to take a note on any page(s)
- Show the bookmark feature – how you can leave off on a certain page
- Show how each e-book contains 5-8 Living History embedded popups – primary source materials like video, audio, reproductions, etc. Find the “Click for More” icon and click it, here are some to choose from:
 - Pg 18 – Haymarket flyers
 - Pg 29 – Beirut Embassy bombing footage
 - Pg 31 – Lockerbie bombing image
 - Pg 49 – 9/11 footage
- Show the search within the book feature by clicking on the search box in the upper right corner of the e-book page. Type the word “embargo” and see the results that are returned. You can then click on the page to jump right to it – and the search term is highlighted.



Click on Explore More and point out:

- Grolier Online articles in FreedomFlix – do NOT need to subscribe to Grolier Online to get these articles
- News Stories
- Primary Sources

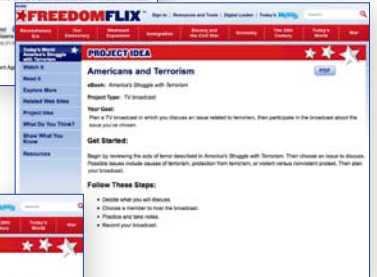
- Lesson Plan – available for each title
