Lots of families live in suburbs outside of a larger city. Suburban houses are often close together. Here's a political map of El Camino Real, a neighborhood in Irvine, California. Irvine is a suburb of Los Angeles. Over 300,000 people live in Irvine. It is 66 square miles in size—almost three times bigger than Manhattan. Look at this map compared to the map of Harlem on pages 8-9. Notice how there are fewer businesses and they are spaced farther apart in a suburban town.
