**PROJECT 1**

**TOOLS**

- 3 small mixing bowls
- Plastic spoon or flat wooden craft stick
- Paper plate

**MATERIALS**

- ¼ cup cornstarch
- 1 tablespoon fine glitter
- 4 teaspoons shampoo
- Blue, purple, and pink food coloring

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1 Pour the cornstarch into one of the bowls.

2 Carefully sprinkle the glitter on top of the cornstarch.

3 Add the shampoo to the bowl and slowly stir everything together. Add another drop or two of shampoo if the mixture is too dry. If the mixture is too wet, sprinkle in a bit more cornstarch.

4 Keep stirring until the slime is completely mixed. Then use your hands to knead the slime until smooth.

5 Divide the slime evenly between the three bowls. Add a drop of food coloring to each bowl. (Use a different color for each one.) Mix in the food coloring.

**SEE IT SHIMMER**

Use your hands to roll each colored slime into a tube. Lay them side-by-side on a paper plate. Twist and swirl the slimes together. The shiny bits of glitter will catch the light making the colorful slime sparkle.

**TOOLS**

Three small mixing bowls    Plastic spoon or flat wooden craft stick    Paper plate    Measuring spoons    Measuring cup

**MATERIALS**

1/4 cup cornstarch    1 tablespoon glitter    4 teaspoons shampoo    Food coloring

Cornstarch acts as a base for the slime.    The small, shiny plastic pieces in glitter reflect light to make the slime shimmer.    This thick liquid binds to particles of cornstarch. That holds the slime together.    Food coloring is a dye that colors the slime.

**Project Instructions**

1. Pour the cornstarch into the bowl.
2. Sprinkle the glitter on top of the cornstarch in the bowl.
3. Add the shampoo to the bowl. Slowly stir everything together. If the mixture is too dry, add more shampoo. If it's too wet, add more cornstarch.

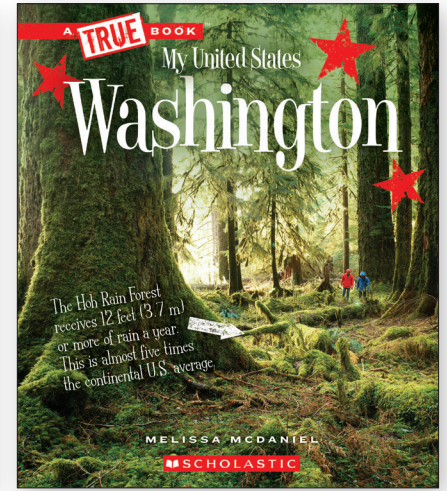
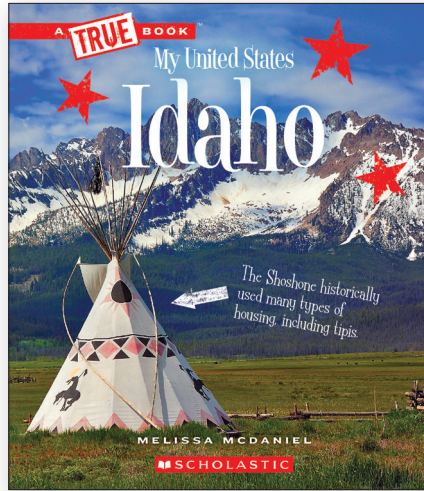

**Geography**

The Pacific Coast forms Oregon's western border. To the north is Washington State. The mighty Columbia River forms most of the border between these two states. One of the largest rivers in the country, the Columbia flows 1,243 miles (2,000 kilometers) from Canada into the Pacific Ocean. Idaho lies to Oregon's east, while California and Nevada are to the south.

This map shows where the higher (red) and lower (green) areas are in Oregon.

**Mount Hood**

With a height of 11,239 feet (3,426 m), the summit of Mount Hood is the highest point in Oregon. This volcano was originally named *Mt. Hood* by the Multnomah people, who have lived in the area for hundreds of years. Its snowy slopes make it a popular destination in northwestern Oregon for skiers and snowboarders. Mount Hood is home to the only ski resort in the country where people can ski year-round. Climbers and hikers also enjoy the challenge of trying to reach the mountain's snowy highest points.
