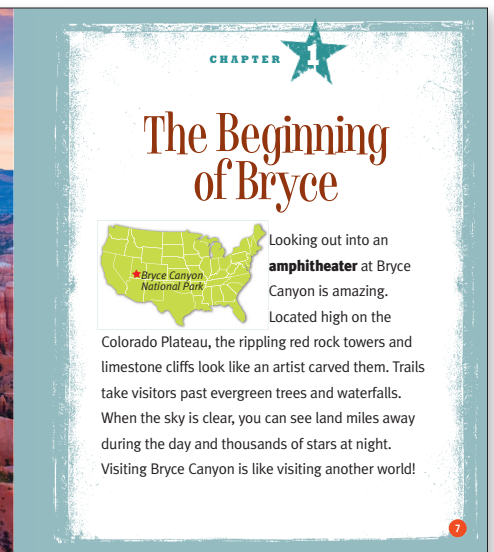
Features:
